12/31/21 NOMINATIONS DEADLINE

Eligibility Requirements

A transplant coordinator must:

- 1** Be currently employed at the transplant center/ hospital
- 2** Be a certified Clinical Transplant Coordinator
- 3** Be currently/ previously employed by the hospital for at least one year
- 4** Have direct patient contact with pediatric heart transplant families

Submission Requirements

A complete online nomination consists of:

- 1** 250 words maximum specifically stating how this individual has demonstrated exemplary patient care and is a pivotal part of their transplant team
- 2** Nominee's curriculum vitae/ résumé
- 3** Each nominee **MUST HAVE** at least one (1) nomination from a transplant family
